### **Anvil Secures Additional Funding for Dikulushi Mine from RMB Resources Limited**

**TORONTO - Anvil Mining Limited** (TSX and ASX: AVM) is pleased to announce that RMB Resources Limited (RMB Resources), part of the Rand Merchant Bank Group of South Africa, has approved a US\$4.0 million increase to the Company's finance facility to an aggregate of US\$8.775 million.

The increase in the facility is to fund the installation of the second ball mill at the Dikulushi Mine and working capital requirements.

The new ball mill was commissioned in early June 2005 in order to increase throughput from 45 tonnes per hour through one mill, to 60 tonnes per hour through the two mills running in series. The increased throughput will allow for increased concentrate production during the second half of the 2005 calendar year.
